

zone ONE

Pride Hill & Castle Foregate - High street brands & refreshments

Castle Gates runs by the train station into Castle Street, which in turn curls past its namesake before leading you onto Pride Hill. Aptly named, this pedestrianised thoroughfare has all the high street shops you'd expect from a modern town. The two shopping centres, The Pride Hill Centre and The Darwin Centre, offer the comfort, convenience and easy access of under cover shopping and are home to the big brands as well as a surprising number of independent shops. Food and beverage outlets dot the length of Pride Hill and offer ample refreshment between retail forays.



zone TWO

St. Mary's, Dogpole, Wyle Cop, St. Alkmund's Place - Specialist shops & historic inns

From St Mary's St to the bottom of Wyle Cop the hunched Tudor buildings house dozens of interesting shops, cafes, restaurants and hotels. This is the oldest part of Shrewsbury but the ancient buildings hold the best in 21st Century shopping and eating. Behind St. Mary's Church is The Parade Shopping Centre, two floors of unique shops and restaurants in a classic Greek renaissance style building. Fashion, niche home wares, gifts, children's clothing, and food can be found on Dogpole. A wander down Wyle Cop will reveal a host of gift, home and fashion ideas in stunning black & white buildings. Head right into the heart of historic Shrewsbury to find Fish Street, St Alkmunds Square and Butcher Row with more fascinating shops to browse and some great pubs and cafes.

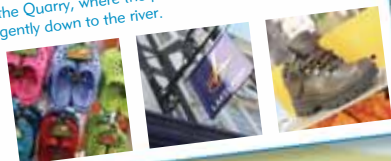

zone THREE

Mardol, Shoplatch and the River - Traditional pubs & contemporary restaurants and local produce.

For the best of fresh local produce and a host of other goods head for the indoor market hall beneath the distinctive clock tower on Shoplatch. Mardol, another historic street, leading down to the River Severn, offers a unique roll call of delis, shops, bars and cafes. Pedestrianised lanes like Roushill Bank and Hills Lane reveal even more intriguing independent shops. Follow the loop of the river and you'll find riverside restaurants with fine food, wine and ales. Keep going until you hit The Quarry, where the picturesque parkland slopes gently down to the river.



zone FOUR

High Street & The Square - Fashion Boutiques and Coffee houses

Welcome to The Square at the heart of the town. Ringed by stylish jewellers, fashion boutiques and coffee shops. High Street, Milk Street and Princess Street are a browsers paradise where you'll discover all manner of specialist shops - books old & new, antiques and even kites. There are lots of great places to eat and drink as well, some with a long and fascinating history. And you won't be able to resist exploring the area's shuts - Peacock Passage, Golden Cross Passage and splendidly named Grope Lane.



Accessibility

On-street parking is free for disabled visitors displaying a badge. Normal charges apply in car parks but there are designated wide spaces. Shopmobility operates from Raven Meadows Car Park, Mon - Sat and hires scooters and wheelchairs to anyone who has difficulties in getting around. Advance booking is recommended. Park and Ride

Make things easier by using the Park and Ride, travelling in from Harlescott, Meole Brace and Oxon. Just £1.20 will pay for your parking and take you right into the centre of Shrewsbury. Buses run every 10 minutes to and from town from designated bus stops.
